PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Fred D. Cole, of Wheeling, West Virginia, USA, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 73rd International Convention, held in St. Louis, Missouri, USA, July 11-14, 1990.
